## **East West Rail update**

The project is being delivered in stages using a Development Consent Order to be granted by Government. Trains are already running between Oxford and Bicester, and the aim is to have trains running the full length of the line between Oxford and Cambridge by the end of the decade.

After 9<sup>th</sup> June, when the latest consultation into the proposed new railway finishes, the East West Rail Company will analyse responses and publish a summary report.

The Company says it will use the consultation responses alongside continuing environmental, economic and technical studies to help shape various aspects of the project. There will be a final stage of consultation on the final route selected.

## **Tools to support your community**

The Community Safety Partnership is launching its first community engagement toolkit. This will provide guidance, training and other tools for residents on how to set up a group focused on enhancing the local community.

The Safety Partnership is working together with South Cambridgeshire District and County Councils, the Police, Fire and Rescue Services, the Probation Service and the NHS, to deal with local crime and antisocial behavior issues.

Evidence has shown that community engagement can create immense power when a group of people with similar interests come together to work towards the same goal.

Within the toolkit there are six areas of focus:

No 5. Tackling road-related concerns, such as speeding and parking.

This item really resonates with the one big problem in this village. We already have the tools, it just needs a few volunteers to operate the 'Speed Watch' cameras.

### **Notes taken from the Steeple Morden Parish Planning Meeting on 17th May**

#### **Planning Applications**

##### **Planning Ref 21/0518/PIP**

64 Hay Street - Erection of a single residential dwelling.

**Refusal - due to impact on neighbouring footpath, and outside village envelope.**

##### **Planning Ref 21/01485/FUL**

2A North Brook End - conversion and adaptation of existing building to a self build dwelling.

**Refusal - due to noise, loss of daylight to neighbour, also size of building, also a new environmental study required.**

##### **Planning Ref 21/0628/FUL**

Chancel Cottage, 34 Hay Street - demolition of existing single storey rear extension and garage building and the construction of a single storey wrap around rear extension, external air source heat pump unit in Siberian Larch housing, single story garden studio and timber frames carport enclosure.

**Approval**

##### **Planning Ref 21/0718/CTY**

Ashwell and Morden Goods Yard, Station Road, Odsey - erection of profiled steel building incorporating automated end of life vehicle depollution systems on concrete pad and regularisation of three car parking spaces.

**Approval - should be aware of junction traffic movement.**

**Junior Football** - the recreation ground will be marked up for three football pitches; a full size pitch, and two junior pitches, to provide for senior football, under 15's, and under 10's.

**Parish Council Meeting held on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June at 7pm.**

- **County Councillor Heather Williams** - reported a complaint by a parishioner about a street light in Hay being covered by tree branches. The tree was also obscuring the traffic speed camera.
- **Leylandii Trees** - still awaiting further quotes.
- **Ashwell Road/Station Road trees** - complaint upheld, the trees are not a hazard.
- **Recreation Ground Checks** - grasscutting has been resumed and cutting around the tennis courts has been carried out safely with regard to the orchids.
- **Parish Council Projects 2021/22** - suggested projects were to tarmac the Village Hall Car Park with a permeable membrane; to put solar panels on the Village Hall; and refurbish the Reading Room/Pavillion outside paintwork.
- **Gypsy, Roma and Traveller Training** - Councillor Celia Upchurch suggested that the parish council should have an emergency plan in place in the event of an illegal encampment by Travellers. Councillor Jeremy Clayton and District Councillor Heather Williams volunteered to be the negotiators.
- **Jubilee Shield Award** - it was decided to award the 2020 shield at the 28<sup>th</sup> August 'We'll meet again' event. The 2020 recipient being Alex da Costa. Councillor Upchurch suggested that a nomination box should be kept at the Post Office for parishioners to nominate people for the 2021 award, complete with simple nomination forms.
- **Leylandii Trees at Church Farm** - trees are to be trimmed and thinned out.
- A contact notice will be placed on the school drop off car park gate.
- Request was granted for a children's party to be held on the recreation ground on 24<sup>th</sup> July.
- **Magpas/Air Ambulance** - a donation of £130 was agreed.
- **Tennis Club** - Avril Gilbert thanked Councillor Nick Badger for organizing the grass cutting around the tennis courts. The picnic table near the tennis courts is to be replaced by a more substantial and larger picnic table.
- **Union Flag** - Councillor Keith Austin was given permission to purchase a new Union Flag.
- **Mark Carroll** was welcomed as a new member of the Parish Council.

The next parish committee meeting will be held on July 12<sup>th</sup>.


The market is held on the first Saturday of every month (except January and August)
