. Almost 3,000 verified residents across South Cambridgeshire have now signed this petition, which will go directly to the GCP board before their meeting to move ahead with these plans. That is a sign that the people have spoken, and the planned charge needs to be scrapped


### CHRISTMAS TREE FESTIVAL


